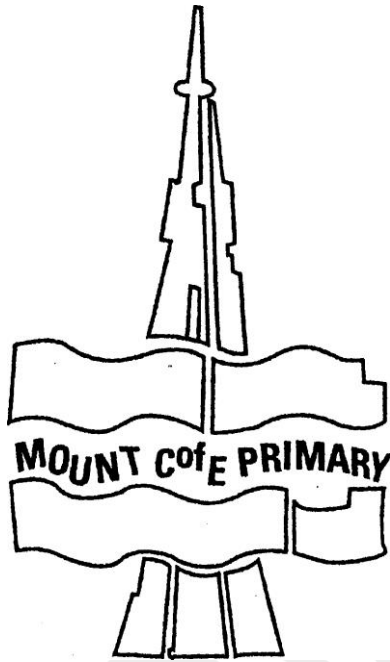

Statement of Intent:

All pupils at Mount CofE Primary School will be active in supporting charitable causes and understand why this is important.

Principles:

We will support local, national, and international charities. All fundraising goals shall be aligned with the School's Values.

Fundraising activities should be fun and imaginative where possible. Permission for cake sales should be sought from the Headteacher.

Parents' Association

The Mount CofE Primary Parents' Association exists to raise funds to buy resources that enrich the education of the children at the Mount CofE Primary School and to provide a forum for parental participation in the school community. The school actively supports the work of the PA.

Criteria

Charities should be chosen in line with the following criteria:

- They have been authorised by the Headteacher.
- Raising money for charity is not seen as a competitive activity when more than one charity is being supported at a particular time of year.
- A fundraising activity must not result in any individual benefiting materially or financially from the activity.
- None of the above activities shall encroach unduly on the school day
- The safety of pupils must be a primary consideration in all fundraising activities.
- Participation in fundraising activities is strictly voluntary for staff and pupils. The personal information of staff, pupils or other individuals will not be shared for the purpose of fundraising without prior consent.

Responsibilities:

- Headteacher: To maintain an overview of charity policy and practice within the school and give strategic direction.
- Classteachers: To support the pupils and the activities/events as appropriate.
- School Office: To receive monies raised in accordance with the school's financial procedures.
